



CATALYST ADULT DAY PROGRAM

(AGES 18+)






Catalyst is a new adult day program option that is designed to support personal growth and independence for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities by focusing on learning life skills.

Members will learn and practice meaningful and necessary skills, promote personal growth and independence, and build confidence in their daily activities to facilitate skill translation to everyday life.

The program enables greater independence through a broad array of life skill training activities, based on member needs. Topics include general household cleaning, personal hygiene, laundry, community engagement, meal prep and planning, and more.

Catalyst participants will be best suited to the program if they have a willingness to learn and engage in both individual and group activities, and can commit to a minimum of 6 months of Catalyst sessions.

Membership

Members are individuals who were registered for program(s) in the last program year or are past members with a current Member Information Form (within 2 years). All others must set an appointment to enroll as a new or lapsed member prior to coming to programs. New members must complete the new member orientation process prior to taking part in programs. Lapsed members may be asked to complete the process as well; the Outreach team will be your first point of contact.

Fees and Registration

- 7. Additional 1:1 support may be recommended at an extra cost in order to ensure a more enjoyable and safe experience for everyone.
- 8. CEL does not provide wheelchairs for members.

Scholarship

CEL is proud to offer financial assistance for various programs. Scholarship awards may be limited and are based on financial needs

and availability of funds. Scholarship applies to full fees only and cannot be combined with any other discount; are not available for dances; and will not be considered for applicants with a past due balance. Awards do not guarantee future assistance. Please return completed scholarship forms before the start of program to be considered for scholarship assistance. Contact Nancy Anderson at 847.315.9901 for further information.

Refund Policy

- A cancellation that occurs prior to the start of a weekly program will incur a service fee
 of \$50 that will offset the credit or refund. No refunds will be given after the first day of
 the weekly program.
- For special events and excursions, cancellations must be made 2 weeks prior to be eligible for a credit or refund. If tickets have been purchased for an excursion, the cost of tickets will not be reimbursed unless the spot is taken by another member. If an excursion is cancelled by the venue or CEL, the program team will offer alternatives depending on the type of excursion and reason for cancellation. CEL has little control over venues that may cancel events.
- If a medical condition prevents a member from participating in a program, a doctor's note is required and will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis for credit or refund.
- Members who move out of the area will be eligible for a refund once the address change is confirmed.

CEL Participation Policy

For the safety and benefit of each member, the Center for Enriched Living has the right to determine the program participation for each person.

Wellness Policy

In order to maintain a healthy environment for all of our members and staff, and to minimize the spread of contagious diseases, we ask that members refrain from attending programs if any of the following conditions exist:

- 1. Strep throat and flu symptoms that might include fever, vomiting, diarrhea, stomachache and headache.
- 2. Active cold symptoms such as, cough and runny nose.
- 3. Contagious skin rashes, questionable rashes, lice, mites, impetigo.
- 4. Eye infections (pink eye).
- 5. A general report of feeling unwell. When members are not feeling well, they are unable to participate and enjoy programming.

Please inform CEL if a member contracts any contagious diseases that will affect attendance. Members can return to CEL after the symptoms have passed or with a doctor's recommendation. To ensure continuity of care to members experiencing medical conditions, CEL asks to be notified of any injuries, new or changes in medical conditions, surgical procedures, etc. A 'return to activities' note will be required before a member may return to CEL programs. Inclement Weather Information

If inclement weather occurs, CEL may determine to cancel programs and/or switch to a virtual format. (Inclement weather can be defined as heat index over 100° or higher, vehicles/sites without air conditioning, tornado warnings, icy road conditions, snow storms, extreme wind chill, etc.) If this does occur, CEL will call members prior to the start of a program to cancel program or offer virtual options, if available.

Can additional supports be provided?

We recognize that some members may require additional assistance to have a meaningful, safe, and successful experience. The program team will assess needs during the new membership process to ensure necessary supports are in place, especially for community-based activities. Our primary responsibility is the safety and security of all members, staff, volunteers, and community partners.

When are program fees due?

Payment is preferred in full at the time of registration. Payment plans can be arranged with a credit card on file. In order to keep your account current, any balances are due in full prior to an event, excursion or recurring program. Please note that programs not meeting minimum enrollment may be subject to cancellation.

Are there any discounted rates or coupons for programs?

CEL is proud to offer financial aid opportunities for programs. Please see page 28 for full details.

What is your credit and refund policy?

- A cancellation that occurs prior to the start of a weekly program will incur a service fee of \$50 that will offset the refund. No refunds will be given after the first day of the weekly program.
- For special events and excursions, cancellations must be made 2 weeks prior to be eligible for a credit or refund. If tickets have been purchased for an excursion, the cost of tickets will not be reimbursed unless the spot is taken by another member. If an excursion is canceled by the venue or CEL, the program team will offer alternatives depending on the type of excursion and reason for cancellation. CEL has little control over venues that may cancel events.
- If a medical condition prevents a member from participating in a program, a doctor's note is required and will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis for credit or refund.
- Members who move out of the area will be eligible for a refund once the address change is confirmed

What if I require a dietary consideration for a program or event?

We strive to accommodate the needs of our members and will do our best to meet requests. In some cases, particularly meals that are planned for a group event or those in the community, it may be difficult to ensure special menu choices. When snacks are offered during programs, members must bring their own gluten-free or dairy-free items as an alternative.
